<u>Statement of the Issue</u>: City staff concur with the request by TRAC, the Trails for Richmond Action Committee, supported by the Richmond Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee, Rich City Rides and Bike East Bay, that the San Francisco Bay Trail be realigned from the eastern to western side of Castro Street and the Richmond Parkway between Hensley Street and Gertrude Avenue. To accomplish this, it is necessary for the City of Richmond to ask the Association of Bay Area Governments Bay Trail Project Board of Directors to amend the Bay Trail Plan, making grant funding sources available for planning, designing and building the trail.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: Adopt a resolution directing the Community Development Director to request the Association of Bay Area Governments Bay Trail Project to realign the Bay Trail Plan from the eastern to western side of Castro Street and the Richmond Parkway between Hensley Street and Gertrude Avenue.
